NOTIFICATION NO. 591Dated Tura, the 24th July, 2014.

It is hereby notified for information of all concerned that the Compartmental Examination for the failed SSLC candidates will be introduced with effect from the SSLC Examination, 2015.

Under the new system a candidate who failed in the SSLC Examination will be allowed to appear the Compartmental Examination only in the failed subjects. Candidates who are desirous of appearing in the Compartmental Examination should note the following provisions:

- (i) The candidates shall avail the Compartmental Examination in the next SSLC Examination.
- (ii) Candidates who failed in maximum **3 (three)** subjects only shall be allowed to sit for Compartmental Examination.
- (iii) The candidate will have to appear only in the Theory Paper, 80 Marks for those who have appeared as Regular Candidates in the SSLC, 2014 and 100 marks for those who have appeared as Private Candidates in the SSLC, 2014. The Internal/Practical Marks will be carried over to the next examination for candidates of the first category.
- (iv) A consolidated marksheet will be issued only to those candidates who pass the Compartmental Examination, which would include the marks of the passed subjects of the previous examination and the Compartmental Examination. The pass criteria of the best of 5 (five) subjects will apply.
- (v) The candidates will be declared as "**passed under Compartmental**" which would be indicated in the marksheet as well as in the Certificate.
- (vi) The prescribed fees as determined by the Board will have to be paid by the candidates.
- (vii) The Compartmental candidates will have to fill up the forms meant only for this category.
- (viii) In the light of the above provision, failed candidates of the SSLC, 2014 will have the option to appear either in all the 6 (six) subjects for hundred marks each as Private Candidates without selection test or only in 3 (three) or 2 (two) subjects (i.e. only subjects failed) as Compartmental candidates.
- (ix) The submission of form for such candidates shall be the same time with the Private candidates without Selection Test, which the Board will intimate in due course of time.

The Heads of the Institutions and the Officers-in-Charge of the Examination Centres are requested to inform the candidates of the above new provision and if any further clarification is required in this regard, you may visit the MBOSE website for more details www.mbose.in or contact the Board Officers during Office hours .
