The Heads of institutions are further directed to file F.I.R. against the applicants with fake marksheets and certificates so that genuine candidates are not deprived of admissions and also to curb the menace of false marksheets and certificates.

The institutions shall be held responsible for any cancellation of the candidature in the near future. It is therefore imperative that immediate action be taken against any candidate with such fake documents.
