It is hereby notified for information of all concerned that the Government of Meghalaya vide letter No. EDU.365/2010/27 dated Shillong, the 28th October, 2011 had approved the Regulations for the Secondary School Leaving Certificate Examination and the Regulations for the Higher Secondary School Leaving Certificate Examination of the Meghalaya Board of School Education.

These Regulations have been framed in exercise of Powers conferred under Section 23 of the Meghalaya Board of School Education Act, 1973 and shall be used as Guidelines for all matters relating to Examinations and other purposes. These Regulations shall come into effect from the Academic Session, 2013 onwards and any change or alteration in the Regulations shall be the prerogative of the Board with approval of the Government.

It is mandatory that all the Institutions shall have to obtain one copy of the above regulations on payment of Rs. 250/- (Rupees two hundred fifty) each from the office of MBOSE, Tura/Shillong.

In pursuance of the decision taken in the 123rd Board meeting held on 19th August, 2010 vide item No. 21 the students of Class XII are allowed to change the subject within a month after the declaration of the results of Class XI Promotion Examination with prior permission from the Board. This provision are applicable only for the students of the same stream.

Apart from the above, it may be noted that the last date for the receipt of the application for changing the institution/stream with supporting documents is 30th April every year and the unsuccessful candidates of the Higher Secondary School Leaving Certificate Examination are allowed to change the Institution/Examination Centre/Stream by 15th July every year on submission of the necessary documents.

The Principals of the Higher Secondary Schools and the Colleges offering +2 Stage of Education are requested to kindly bring this to the notice of all concerned.

The above notification shall remain in force until further order.

It is hereby notified for information of all concerned that, in order to ensure transparency and accountability, the Board will continue the system of Re-evaluation of Answer Scripts of the SSLC/HSSLC Examinations. A photocopy of the Answer Script(s) will be given on request along with a prescribed fee. In the light of this provision, the following points may kindly be noted for information and necessary action.

1. A period of 20 (twenty) days after the declaration of results will be given to candidates to apply for a photocopy and Re-evaluation of Answer Script(s). On the expiry of this period, applications shall not be entertained.

2. An application for Re-evaluation will be entertained only after the candidate has first obtained the photocopy of the Answer Script(s). On application, a photocopy of the Answer Script(s) with marks will be provided to a candidate and thereafter a window period of 3 (three) days will be given to apply for Re-evaluation, if so desire. However, while giving the photocopy of the Answer Script(s), names of the Head Examiner, Examiner and Scrutiniser which appear on the scripts will be concealed.

3. A candidate who desires to get a photocopy of the Answer Script(s) shall have to sign an undertaking with a pledge to maintain utmost confidentiality. Under no circumstances will the candidate reveal the photocopy to the press or take any action with malafide intentions of maligning the Board. Any violation of the undertaking will render the result of the candidate null and void and the examination of the candidate will be liable to be cancelled.
