NOTIFICATION NO. 829 **Dated Tura, the 5th March, 2019.**

In pursuance of the Board's decision, in its 136th Board Meeting held on 22nd Nov., 2018 vide Agenda No. 2.ix, it is hereby notified for information of all concerned that, the 'Class XII Selection Fail students' who have not been re-admitted and as such, fail to attend regular classes shall be allowed to avail the provision of appearing the selection test conducted by their respective institution in the succeeding year, subject to the following conditions:

1. This shall apply to students of all the streams (Arts, Science and Commerce).
2. The said students should have at least 75% of attendance in class XII.
3. They shall attend at least 20 practical classes in subjects involving practical in the succeeding year.
4. If such 'Class XII selection fail students' qualify the selection examination of the succeeding year, they shall appear as private candidates. They shall fill in the HSSLC Examination application form meant for Private Candidates.
5. This provision shall not apply to students who take transfer/change institution/stream. If such student takes transfer/change the stream then he/she shall have to be a regular student.
6. By 30th April each year, such 'Class XII Selection Fail' students shall have to seek permission from the Board (with NOC from the head of institution and other relevant documents) to appear HSSLC Examination as a Private Candidate."
7. This notification shall come into effect from the academic session 2019-2020.

Note:


- i. It is most desirable that the 'Class XII Selection Fail' students take re-admission and attend regular classes. Denial of re-admission to such students in their respective schools is against the interest of the students. Only in the event where such student(s) is unable to get re-admitted due to paucity of seat, the above provision shall be applied.
- ii. All institutions should allow the students to sit for the selection test in the succeeding year and on passing the same, the students shall appear HSSLC Examination as a Private candidate. This shall in no way affect the pass percentage of the concerned institution.
- iii. As the new syllabus has come into effect for the Science and Commerce streams, all institutions should allow 'Class XII selection fail students' of Science and Commerce Streams, who are desirous of continuing in these streams, to re-admit in their respective institutions for this academic session (2019-20) so that these students are equipped with the new syllabus.
