In partial modification to Notification No. 914, dated Tura, the 28th July, 2021, it is hereby notified for information of all concerned that setting of Question Papers in the Old Course of studies for the subjects Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Mathematics, Accountancy, Business Studies, Entrepreneurship, Informatics Practices, Economics and Computer Applications shall be discontinued with effect from HSSLC Examination, 2022 onwards.

Therefore, the Non-Regular candidates **who have opted for these subjects** and had failed in the HSSLC, 2021 (or earlier examinations) are advised to either drop these subjects or to take re-admission in Class XII, attend regular classes and appear as Regular candidates (since subject change is not permissible for Non-Regular candidates and unlike the old course, some of these subjects in the New Course now have a practical component). Further, such candidates will not have the opportunity of taking Compartmental and Improvement **in these subjects** in the ensuing HSSLC Examinations.
