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### Introduction

With the adoption of NCERT textbooks for English, Mathematics and Science, the Directorate of Educational Research and Training (DERT) Meghalaya and Reach to Teach Foundation developed a Learning Outcomes-Based syllabus in February 2024. This document maps each chapter of the NCERT textbooks to specific Learning Outcomes (LOs) as prescribed by the NCERT, NIPUN Bharat, as well as the National Curriculum Framework (Foundational Stage and School Education). A corollary to the Learning Outcome mapped syllabus was the development of a LO-based Assessment Blueprint. In March 2024, a four-day workshop was held to develop this assessment blueprint. The participants included faculty members of the DERT and DIETs, teachers and members from Reach to Teach Foundation. To ensure uniformity and effectiveness of assessments, the LO-Mapped syllabus has been used to add weightage per chapter and per LO for English, Mathematics and Science.

This document consists of Assessment Blueprints for summative and formative assessments for each subject and grade (except Classes 1 and 2). Marks have been allotted for different types of question and chapter-wise weightage have been assigned, depending on the rigor and coverage of each chapter.

For Classes 1 and 2, the Assessment Blueprints are not bifurcated into internal assessments and half-yearly/final Examinations. At the foundational stage, it is important for students to be assessed continuously through a series of short, activity-based assessments. These can be conducted after the completion of a topic in class. This continuous evaluation through a series of formative assessments will help ease the burden on the students and will help teachers assess their class's performance without the students having to sit for long hours and write Examinations.

The assessment structure across classes has been envisaged as follows:

- Classes 1 and 2: Continuous formative assessments as mentioned above
- Classes 3 to 5: Division of the annual calendar into two terms. The internal assessment for each term will be for 40 marks. The half-yearly and annual Examination will be for 60 marks each
- Classes 6 to 8: Division of the annual calendar into two terms. The internal assessment for each term will be for 20 marks. The half-yearly and annual Examination will be for 80 marks each

This document is intended to help teachers structure their formative and summative assessments effectively. The structured and consistent assessment of students will ensure students achieve the required learning outcomes and will help set them up for success as they navigate their academic journey at school.
